1. Opening of Meeting (09:30)

3. Thematic Session on Adaptation Investment (09.50)

The thematic session on adaptation investment involved a presentation from the OECD representatives on the Policy Framework for Investment in Adaptation that was launched at UNFCCC COP29 in November 2024; presentation from the Central Bank representative on relevant work it is doing in the area of adaptation, a response from the Department of Taoiseach as well as an open discussion on the challenges to adaptation investment in Ireland.

The Chairperson thanked the representatives from the OECD, Central Bank and Department of the Taoiseach for the contribution to the session and emphasized the need for further follow up work in this area.

4. Advanced Draft of Our Changing Climate in 2024 Annual Review (11.50)

The Committee discussed the advanced draft of Our Changing Climate which is planned to be published in March 2025 as the first of the 2025 Annual Review publications. Comments were provided on the draft recommendations that were presented and it was noted that the draft was open for written feedback and would be updated and revised for submission to the February meeting of the Climate Change Advisory Council.
